



MOST ICE-CREAM SCOOPS THROWN & CAUGHT IN ONE MINUTE

The following act as a guide to the specific considerations and undertakings, in addition to the general requirements as detailed in the General Rules of the Record Breakers' Pack, for any potential attempt on the above record.

They should be read and understood by all concerned – organisers, participants and witnesses – prior to the event.

Please note that, as detailed in the Agreement Regarding Record Attempts, these guidelines in no way provide any kind of safety advice or can be construed as providing any comfort that the record is free from risk.

GUIDELINES

The record is for the most ice-cream scoops thrown and caught in one minute.

1. Thrower and catcher must be 8m apart. Marks on the floor should indicate the 8m distance.
2. The catcher can use any brand of commercially available wafer cornet/cone.
3. The ice-cream must be in its original container and no scoops can be made in advance.
4. The attempt will start and end on a given signal.
5. The thrower can only start scooping the ice-cream when the attempt is underway.
6. The catcher can only use one hand to catch the ice-cream in his cornets/cones and can compact the ice-cream with his thumb.
7. Each complete cone must be placed in a rack to be counted at the end of the attempt.
8. Only completed cones count towards the final total. Any broken cones, or cones where the ice-cream has fallen out will not count towards the final total.
